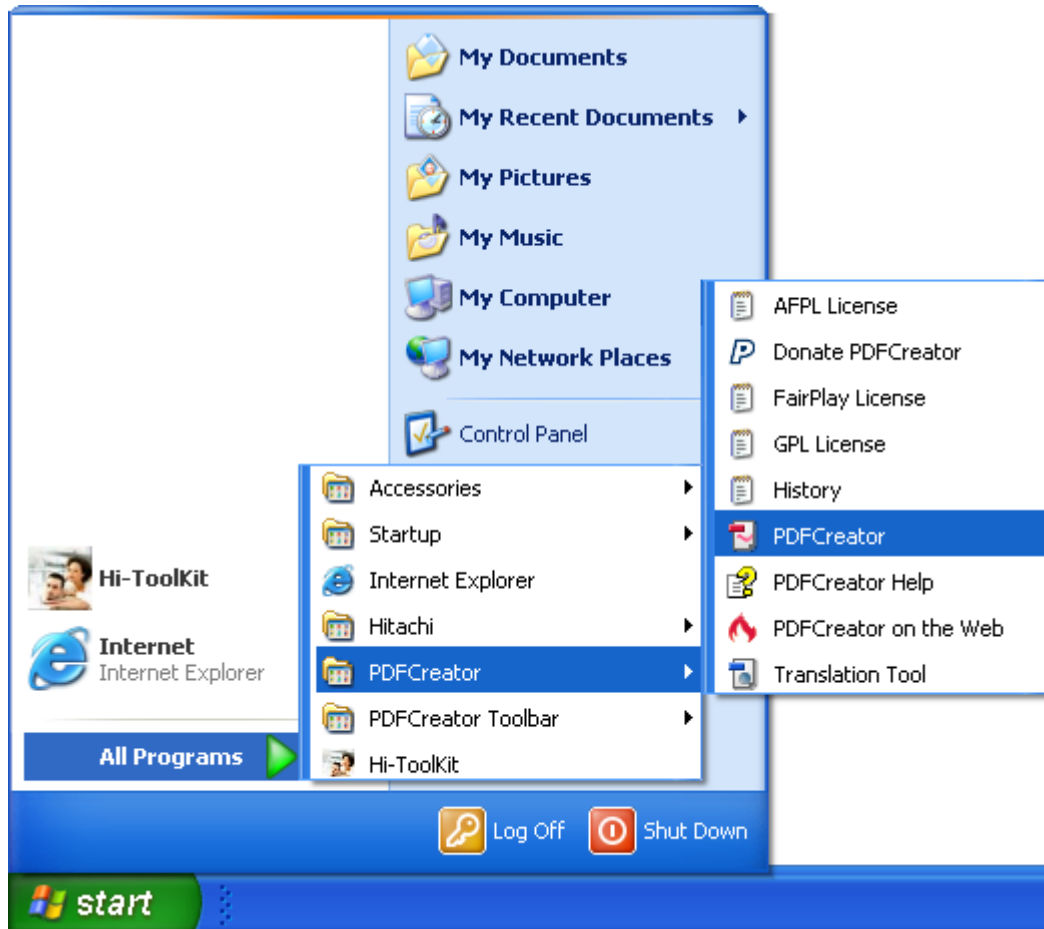
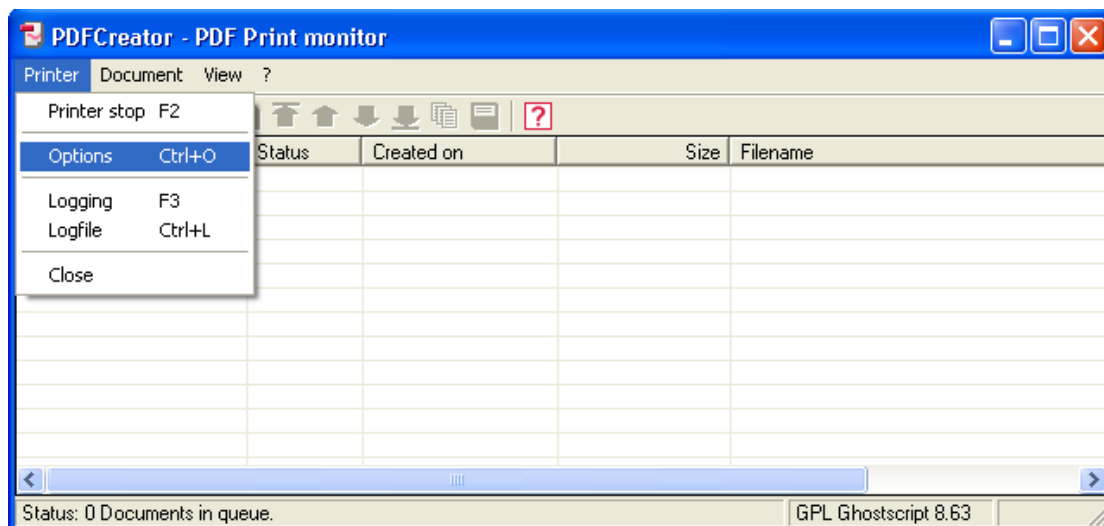


HiToolKit Print Quality FAQ

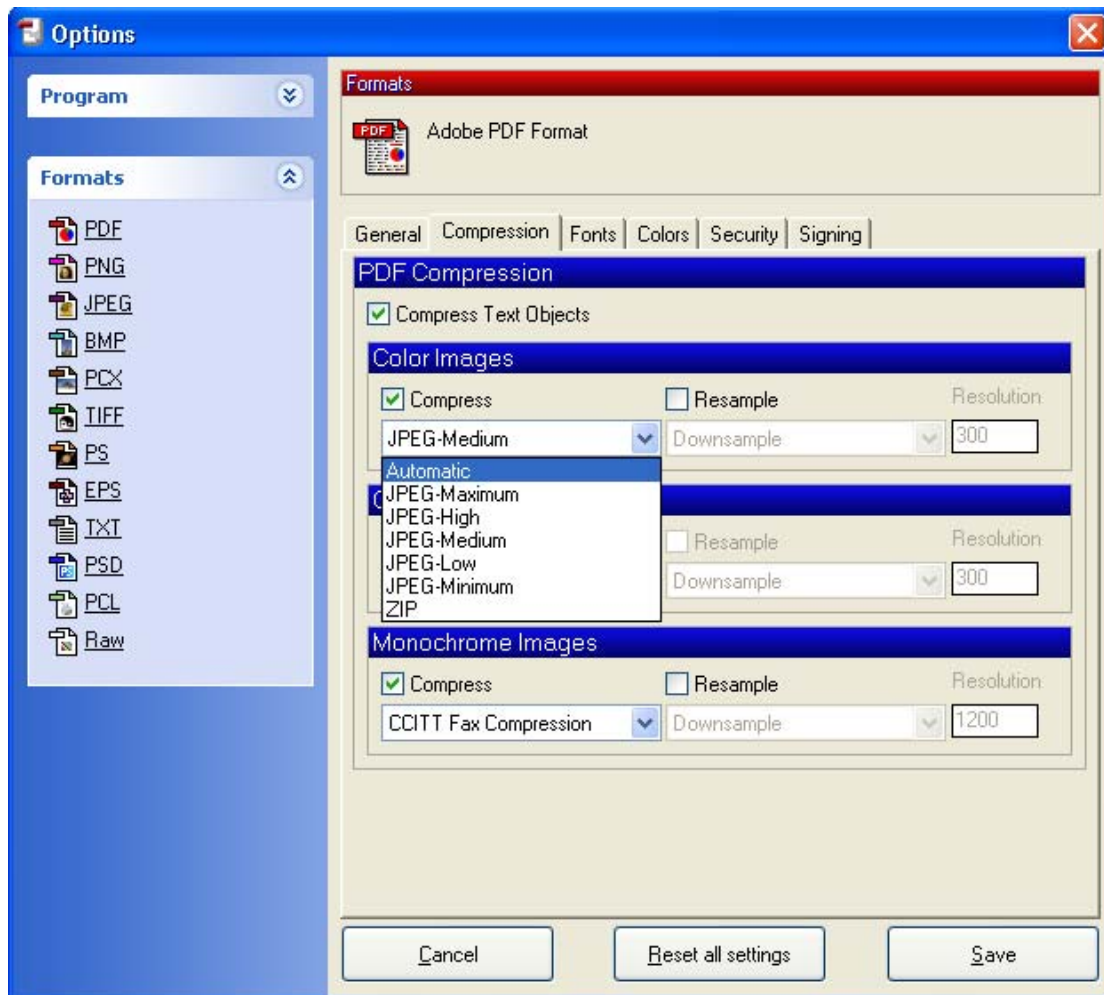
1) Open PDFCreator by navigating to Start > All Programs > PDFCreator > PDFCreator



2) Click "Printer" on the toolbar and select "Options"



3) Click "Formats" on the left hand side bar, select the "PDF" file type, go to the "Compression" tab and change the "Color Images" setting to the desired quality level.



Recommended Settings

Compression is used to reduce the file size to make the HiToolkit schematics smaller and easier to share by email. The default “Auto” setting means “JPEG-Maximum” is typically utilised by PDFCreator for printing HiToolkit files to reduce the file size as much as possible.

Often this setting is too aggressive, by removing too much detail the piping/electrical schematics can appear blurred. Reducing the compression improves the print quality, but at the cost of large file sizes.

Hitachi recommend the following settings:

- JPEG-Medium** Best compromise on file size and quality.
- JPEG-Minimum** Best quality but large file sizes (approx 50% larger than medium setting)
