



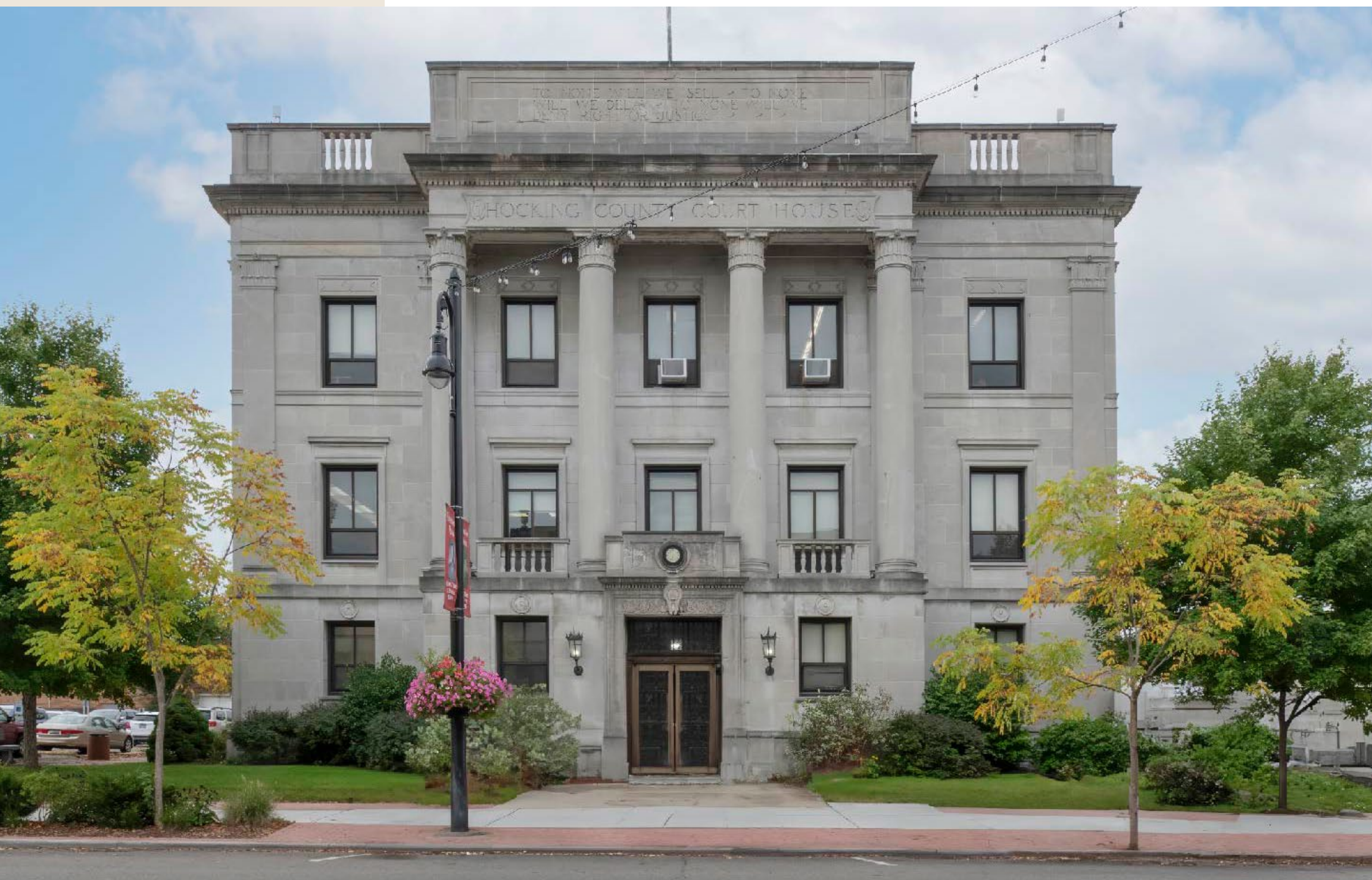

## 100-YEAR OLD COURTHOUSE BUILDING SUFFERS FROM POOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL

Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the building has served as Hocking County Courthouse for a century. As the 100 anniversary of the building was approaching, the decision was made to retrofit the HVAC system and finally bring modern comfort inside the Courthouse.

## HITACHI VRF PROVIDED THE SOLUTION DUE TO ITS GREAT FLEXIBILITY AS WELL AS THE HEAT RECOVERY SYSTEM

The client preferred a centralized cooling and heating system that would be easier to maintain than the previous equipment.

In total, 3 Hitachi VRF units were installed on the roof and ground floor, topped with snow kits for winter. Inside the building, 62 indoor units and 8 heat recovery changeover boxes were installed.
