100-YEAR OLD COURTHOUSE BUILDING SUFFERS FROM POOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL

Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the building has served as Hocking County Courthouse for a century. As the 100 anniversary of the building was approaching, the decision was made to retrofit the HVAC system and finally bring modern comfort inside the Courthouse.

HITACHI VRF PROVIDED THE SOLUTION DUE TO ITS GREAT FLEXIBILITY AS WELL AS THE HEAT **RECOVERY SYSTEM**

The client preferred a centralized cooling and heating system that would be easier to maintain than the previous equipment.

In total, 3 Hitachi VRF units were installed on the roof and ground floor, topped with snow kits for winter. Inside the building, 62 indoor units and 8 heat recovery changeover boxes were installed.
